



NAC CANADA POLICY: SNOW SAFETY

As children enjoy playing in the snow, it's important to understand the risks associated with building snow forts. One cubic foot of snow weighs approximately five pounds. If a snow fort is 3 feet high, a collapse could place approximately 500 pounds of snow on top of a child.

As we move forward to ensure the care and safety of our children, snow forts or snow caves are prohibited on church property. In addition, children should not play in areas where snow removal or clearing are taking place.
